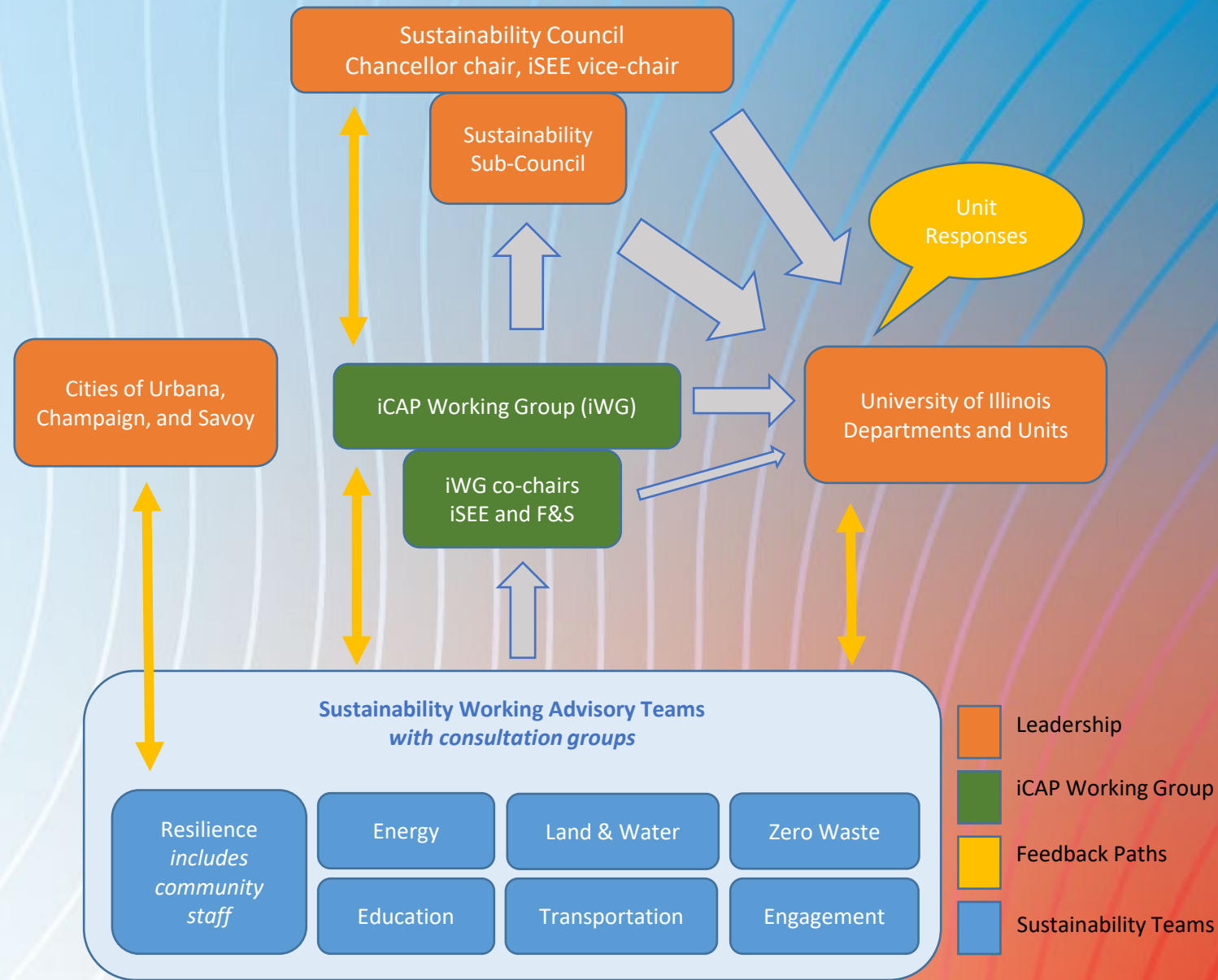
# The Illinois Climate Action Plan
