

## Living lab and campus sustainability

- "living lab is an open innovation environment centered on users to test concepts and ideas on real scenarios with multidisciplinary research teams" (smartcities.ieee.org)
- Merging campus facilities management and academics to help students address sustainability issues (Cohen and Lovell, 2014)
- Campus sustainability is crucial for universities to remain competitive and viable in training students to battle sustainability challenges

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## The living lab at Harvard University



Colorado State University was the only Institution ranked as Platinum; U of I was ranked as gold but in the low band

## **Some Issues**

- Faculty and students are not aware of academic opportunities involved in campus sustainability projects
- Facility operation and management staffs are not aware the benefits of collaborating with faculty and students (Savanick et al., 2006)
- Appropriate funding mechanisms and incentives are not in place to properly engage all groups



# What may we need to do?

- Promote using campus sustainability projects as testbed for research and education projects
- Seek additional funding for campus sustainability projects
- Strengthen the engagement of students, faculty, and staff beyond our current practices
- Strengthen the collaboration with communities



#### iCAP projects and iCAP Portal: Resources for R&E

- Many of the projects/facilities have already been used for R&E
- There exist potentials for using the projects to attract major external grants

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















### Map iCAP projects and National Research Program
