Introduction

1. Overview of Goals for FY26

- We reviewed the Transportation Team's 2020 iCAP goals ([link](#))
- Our goals for the coming year:
 - o Submit two recommendations within the next month, one regarding air travel emissions and one regarding EV charging infrastructure (goals 3.4 and 3.5).
 - One of the ways the team can make progress on goals is through submitting recommendations to the iCAP Working Group, asking for the University to implement programs or policy changes. The last recommendation we submitted was several years ago.
 - o Continue research on commuter program and brainstorm ways to encourage people to give up their university parking pass (goal 3.4).
- These are our main priorities, but if any team members have ideas for movement towards other goals we can focus on implementation!

Recommendation Process

We walked through the iCAP working group structure and the life of recommendations.

- Once a recommendation is submitted, it goes to the iCAP Working Group
- They have the choice to implement the recommendation, send it back to the iCAP group for more information, or pass it up the chain for further approval.
 - o Depending on cost, budget availability, and level of impact, the iCAP Working Group will implement it or sent to the Sustainability Sub Council or the Sustainable Council (which contains the Chancellor).

In the case of the air travel emissions recommendations, it may go to the Sub Council due to the system-wide change it would mean across all three U of I campuses.

Funding Process

A great option for funding some of the projects we are talking about (specifically EV charging on campus) is the SSC Green Fund. Once we submit the recommendation, we will draft and submit it. Goal is to get the recommendation approved this semester and fill out the SSC application in spring.
