Larry Uphoff (Student Affairs)	While we support sustainable standards we understand that they come at a cost and that if we adopt these standards we will have to significantly increase our parking rates to cover this kind of renovation. Another option is for costs related to these standards be covered by a centrally held fund and not by the Parking Department. Lots are resurfaced on a recurring basis and this would limit our ability to resurface based on our schedule. This may also require vertical lots and the removal of proximal lots because they would be too costly to resurface in this way.
