# Student Code policy update: "Operation of bicycles"

#### **Current version:**

### § 2-605 Operation of Bicycles

- (a) Bicycles on campus must be operated at all times in accordance with the current University Bicycle Ordinance located at go.illinois.edu/bikeordinance.
- (b) Bicycles shall be parked on campus only in an area that is designated by the presence of racks for bicycle parking.
- (c) Students may register bicycles for campus use with Facilities and Services at no charge.
- (d) Bicycle theft should be reported to the University Police Department at (217) 333-1216

## § 2-605 Operation of Bicycles

- (a) Bicycles on campus must be operated at all times in accordance with the current University Bicycle Ordinance located at go.illinois.edu/bikeordinance.
- (b) Bicycles must be parked and locked on campus only in an area that is designated by the presence of racks for bicycle parking at go.illinois.edu/bikeracks.
- (c) Students must register bicycles for campus use at a one-time cost per bicycle, as described in the <u>Bicycle Regulations CAM policy FO-13</u>, and collect a tamper resistant and theft deterrent Shield sticker (bicycle registration tag) from one of the several locations. - (d) Bicycle theft should be reported to the University Police Department at (217) 333-1216
