

- 2016: signed the Resilience Commitment, pledging to build resilience to climate change with our local community










Total Campus Greenhouse Gas Emissions



- Guiding the discussions during meetings
- Delegating follow-up steps as needed
- Connecting campus efforts to the larger global knowledge base
- Ensuring faculty leadership in support of campus sustainability goals






Illinois Climate Action Plan (iCAP) 2020

- SMART objectives for each theme, tracked on iCAP Portal (http://icap.sustainability.illinois.edu)











Completed: Work is complete and the results are achieved.










Successful: These were transmitted and accepted/approved by the related department.


