### **Commuter Program**

- iCAP 2020 objective 3.4.1: "Develop a Commuter Program (Bus, Bike, and Hike) for faculty and staff. Register 100 people by FY24 and 500 people by FY30.
- Parking and F&S are the responsible campus units.
- Goal is to incentivize staff and faculty to leave personal vehicles on campus, requires staff and faculty to relinquish parking permits.
- 6 of 14 Big Ten schools have some version of this program for employees and/or students.

#### Walkability Audit

- The Transportation Demand Management Department (F&S) is conducting a walkability audit of campus in FY22.
- Project will feature two data collection surveys:
  - Walkability questionnaire focusing on the general walkability for a small block in the campus.
  - Deficiency reporting focused on identifying specific faults.

Campus Transportation Advisory Committee

- CTAC is an advisory body to Transportation Demand Management at F&S and the campus community on matters regarding transportation on campus.
- The committee will review aspects of surface transportation on campus and the interaction of all modes of travel on campus.
- Responsibilities of the committee:
  - Identify and share info about pedestrian safety initiatives and priorities.
  - Review and make recommendations for prioritizing bicycle infrastructure, education, and enforcement on campus.
  - Provide advisory input to the commuter program.
  - Review and comment on matters relating to student, faculty, and staff transportation when needed.

#### Fleet Replacement Recommendation

- Objective 3.1: Establish written replacement plans for at least 80% of campus fleets by FY24 to improve university-owned vehicle fuel efficiency.
- Progress started last year but halted due to a change in membership.
- Intention of recommendation was to figure out optimal method for replacing vehicles with EVs or hybrids when Parking Dept. purchases new vehicles for the fleet.
