Hi Morgan, Ximing and Meredith

Thanks for putting this proposal together. I agree with the need for a person like Stacy to help us move forward on our Resilience Commitment.

My thoughts are as follows. I see the deliverables articulated at the end of the document- but they include those ranging for the next 6 months and till 2024. Would it be possible to have a clear set of deliverables for Stacy for the next 6 months identified separately from the longer run goals, so we have more clarity on what we can expect from her in this short term? It would be great if a few tangible outcomes for her work could be listed in that. It could include expectations from her, iSEE and others in the near term to work collaboratively. Also a plan/person and format for her reporting periodically during this time will be good to identify.

Hi Madhu and Ehab,

Per the attached Carbon Credits MOU, the two of you are responsible for evaluating and approving the use of Carbon Credit sales funding. The Carbon Credit funding is tracked in the attached file, showing \$855,917.85 currently available to allocate. (We are also expecting additional funds to be deposited in the next few weeks with a sale that is currently in progress.)

Please approve: \$17,500 for Resilience Development

The Resilience Commitment, signed in 2016, was incorporated in the iCAP for the first time in the 2020 version, with a list of seven specific objectives. iSEE is the primary department responsible for helping campus achieve these ambitious goals. We request approval to fund a 20-hour/week contract with ARI to have Stacy Gloss work to develop the structure and plan for completing these objectives. The cost of a six-month agreement is \$17,500. Please see attached proposal file for more detail. We have also attached Stacy's resume, with highlighting added showing some of her relevant experience.

With your approval of this funding, we will initiate a discussion with ARI.
