Over the course of the Spring 2022 semester, SSLC leadership accomplished:

- Bolstered collaboration between environmental RSOs on the UIUC campus. The SSLC discussed incentives with Student Affairs for participation with the SSLC. Weekly board meetings and monthly full meetings continued per usual, including in-person socials with SSLC constituents.
- Bolstered collaboration between other Illinois schools like the University of Illinois
 Chicago, University of Illinois Springfield, and Illinois State University. Both SECS and
 ISG may play significant roles in this relationship-building. Via the College Climate
 Coalition, a group of students from the Big 10 Climate Coalition, we worked to expand
 sustainability efforts and collaboration across sustainability students from the Big 10
 schools.
- Host Earth Month events. The SSLC hosted a largely successful Green Quad Day with over 50 organizations tabled and a movie night in the Illini Union. We also hosted another series of Tuesday Talks, including discussions on alternative protein research, activism, a circular economy, and water privatization.
- Continued to monitor the fight for fiscal divestment from fossil fuels.
