Past Objectives and Projects

Improvements in LEED Certifications

- F&S tracks LEED certifications for University buildings
- BIF, Lincoln Hall, Bousfield = LEED Platinum

Power Plant Carbon Sequestration

- SSC funded project

Retro-commissioning (2008-continued)

- Analyzing building heating, ventilation, air conditioning
- Changing operating systems to optimize energy conservation
- Average energy savings of 25% per building

Wind Energy Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) - 2016 – 2026


- Urbana campus purchases 25,000 MWh (5% of total annual electricity use)

Illini Lights Out

- Student-led initiative to turn lights out around buildings on campus to conserve energy and support culture of sustainability






- Studies and surveys to assess transportation practices

- Evaluated UIUC fleet vehicles to be replaced with EVs
- 2022 Mode Choice Survey
- Walkability Audit



Current Objectives and Projects

- Installing public use electric vehicle charging stations
 - 20 charging stations already installed
- Encouraging bicycle use and improving safety
 - Through education, infrastructure, and enforcement
- Decreasing fleet emissions
 - By incrementally replacing fleet with EVs and low emissions gas vehicles
- Sustainably managing university transportation systems
- Discussion with Prairie Research Institute and Public Safety about Fleet Replacement Plans





- Riparian habitat for wildlife



DORNER DRIVE RETENTION POND Conceptual Design & Phases

- Phase 1:** Repair Retaining Wall – Fall/Winter 2020
- Phase 2:** Remove existing vegetation & Install seed mix(es) – Spring 2021
- Phase 3:** Install designed, specific plant plugs – Fall 2021
- Phase 4:** Maintain new established landscape – Spring 2020 forward


Approximate seeded area: 48,000 sq ft





Campus Landscape Master Plan




- Common milkweed plantings

- What to expect in the near and far future: soil quality sampling and reducing potable water use





Dining Services

Reusable Containers



- Reduce food waste and single use materials through this pilot program
- Objective 5.4: Promote food scraps reduction on campus through a behavior change campaign, and tracking and recovery of surplus food for donation, with at least five new areas tracking and reporting their food waste by FY22.

USED CONTAINERS



NO TRASH

- There are now more than 2,000 containers in use, and we are working on another recommendation to track this data more closely
- Program is now expanded to all 5 dining facilities!


Present Project

Grind2Energy

- All residence halls are currently utilizing Grind2Energy systems
- Objective 5.2: Reduce the total campus waste going to landfills from 5,049 tons in FY19 to 4,544 tons or less in FY24, which is a decrease of at least 10%.
- Lincoln / Allen system Funded by Facilities & Services and iSEE Carbon Credit Sales Fund



1. The food waste goes through the grinder and becomes a "slurry."
2. The slurry is pumped into a 5000-6000 gallon holding tank right outside of the dining hall.
3. When the tank gets 80% full, a vendor is notified and the slurry is picked up from the holding tank by a liquid vacuum truck.
4. Once the slurry is dropped off at the Urbana Champaign Sanitary District, they put it in an anaerobic digester.
5. From there, they collect methane from the digester and produce electricity to run their plant.

Future Project

- Work with Athletics to establish Zero Waste practices at regular sporting events
- Provide a Zero Waste liaison to student athlete committees/clubs
- November 14: Zero Waste Basketball game before America Recycles Day
 - Objective 5.3: two major zero waste events
 - Setting the standard for future collaborations with IL Athletics




Challenges...

Misconceptions about the waste stream

- Past messaging that F&S sorts all landfill waste; some people still hold this belief true today despite new awareness campaigns. Always use the recycling bin!

Many are still unaware of what is recyclable

Lack of awareness on the process of how the university recycles and where University waste goes




WHERE WE'VE BEEN

Student teams create advertising material and resources for campus sustainability initiatives and sustainability engagement.





Objective 8.6: Vision Zero

Community Resilience: Current Projects

Urbana led Geothermal and Solar Urbana-Champaign

(These 2022 programs close 10/31.)

- Making the switch to geothermal easier and more affordable. 28 systems; 118 tons of capacity.
- Broadening local solar PV development: 302 systems; 2,635 kw solar capacity since 2016!

Coordinated Rainwater Management: Objective 8.2




