- 3) Will buy Fix-It Stations if funding is available in the spring



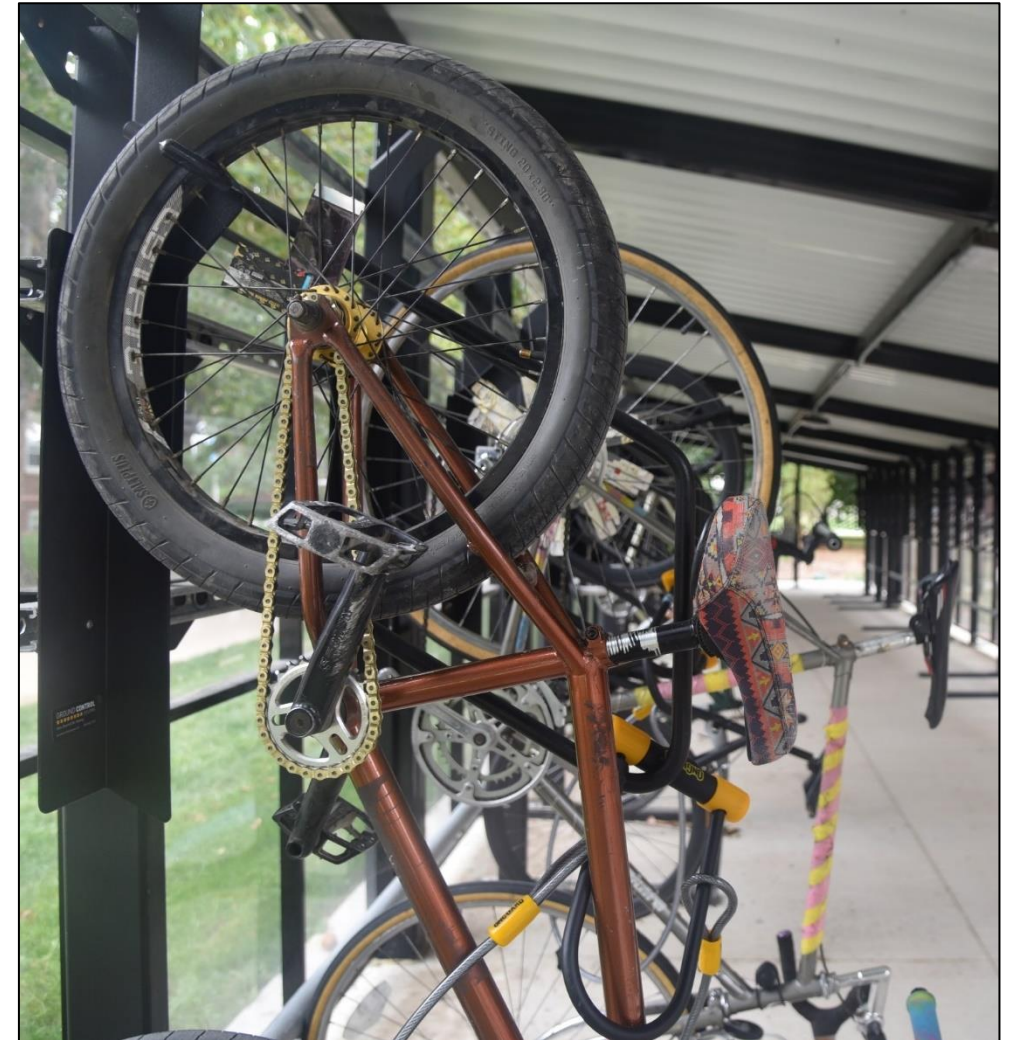

We are going to make sure that there is funding available for the Fix-It Stations in the spring before ordering them.

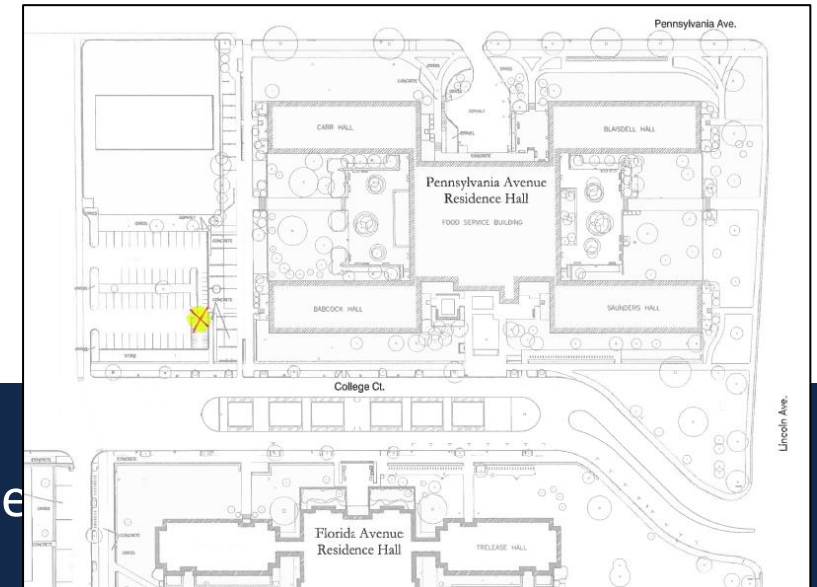
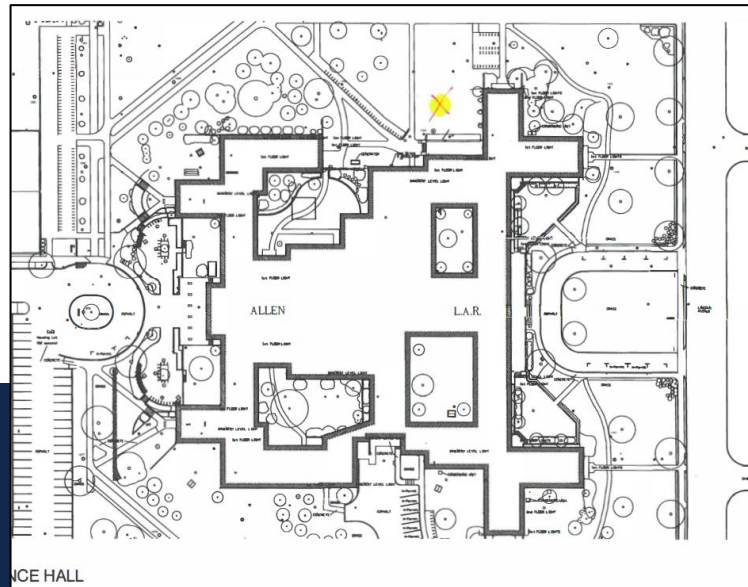
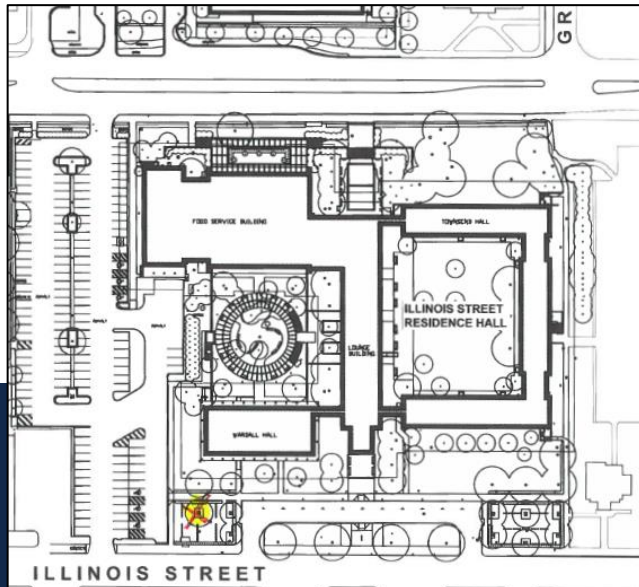
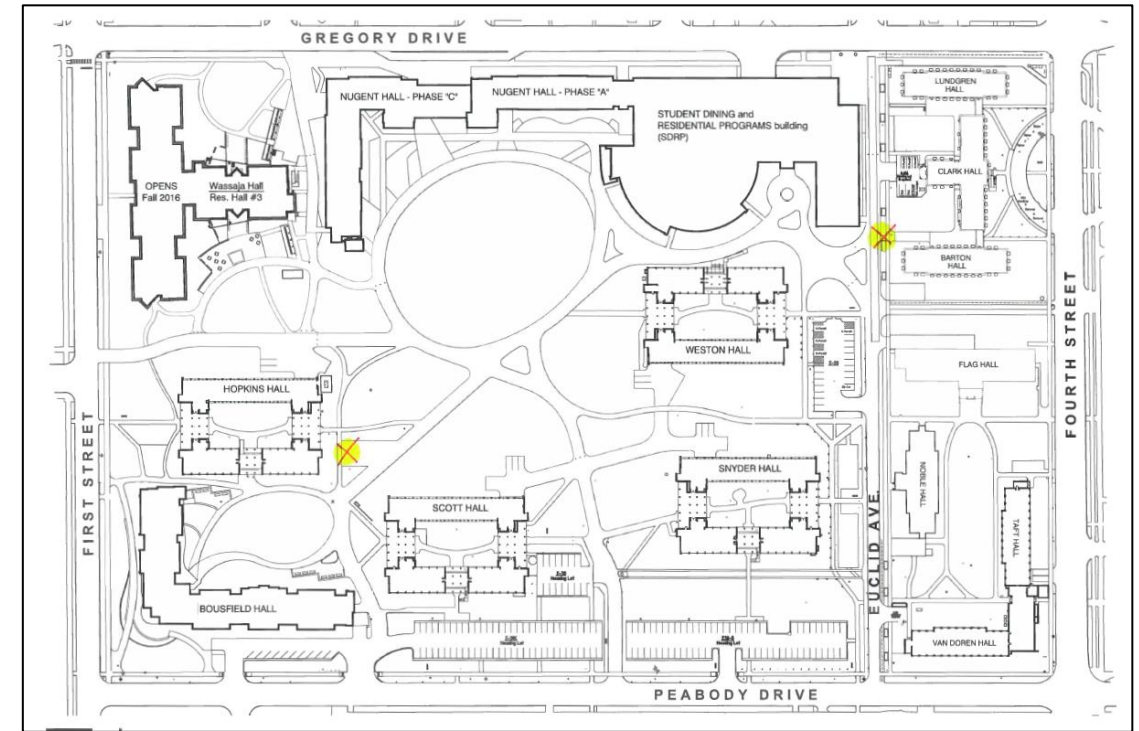

- Particularly useful for the Smart Campus effort, which allows students and researchers to access real-time data



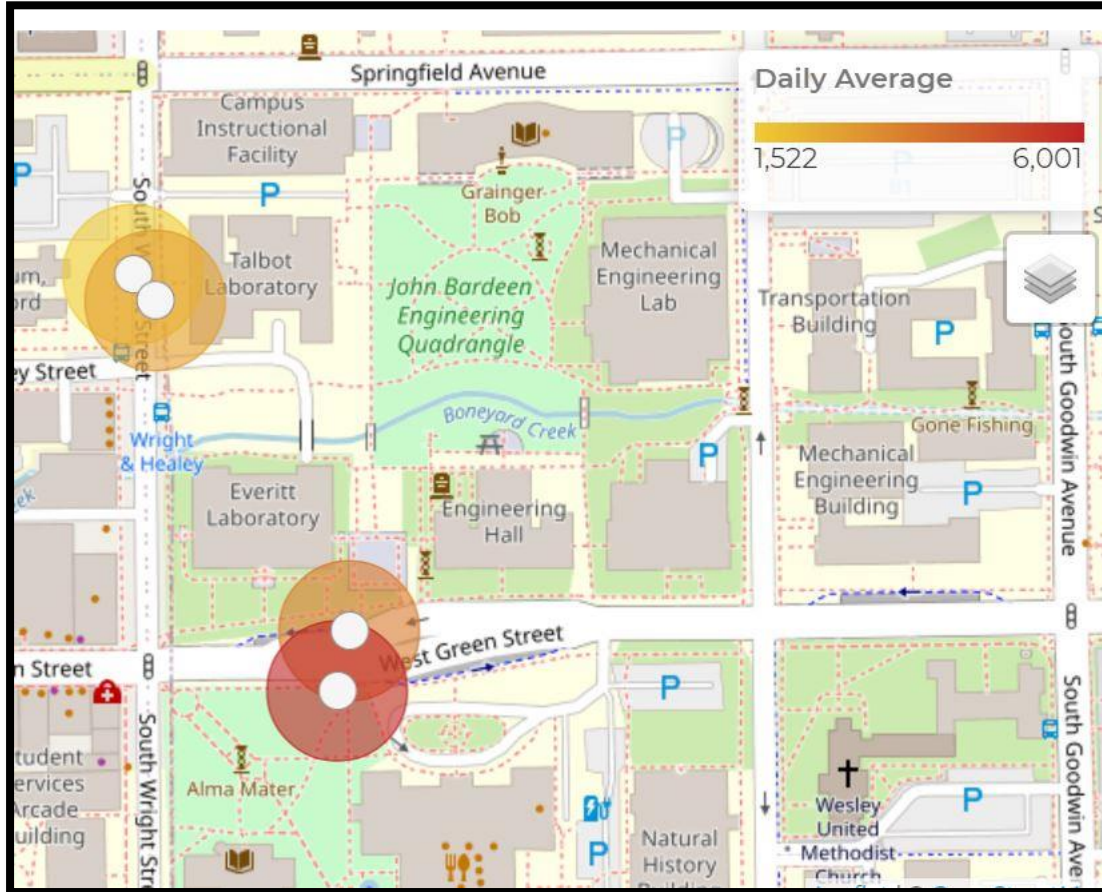
