

- Updated the Bike at Illinois map with the most up to date bike parking locations




Projects using FY22 funding balance


- Replace bike repair stations outside University Housing




New multi-use path along Springfield Ave

- Monitor pedestrian and bicycle activity there
- Particularly useful for the Smart Campus effort, which allows students and researchers to access real-time data




