1) Meadow at Orchard Downs

- a. Pam Leiter, who teaches the Hand-on Native Plant Care class (NRES 294), joined our conversation on restoration of the meadows at Orchard Downs.
- b. We discussed progress made so far by From the Ground Up.
 - i. The project lead at From the Ground Up for the Orchard Downs project is Linnea Turner. She shared that they have the funds (\$9000) to support the project but could benefit from some guidance or the integration of an NRES 285 course to support the process.
 1. Megan will reach out to Linnea about what type of guidance they need. If it pertains to the expertise of Brent or Pam, Megan will refer Linnea to them.

2) Review of iCAP Land & Water objectives with anticipation of the 2025 iCAP rewrite

- a. Objective 4.1: Reduce Water Consumption – The team is considering the expansion of this objective beyond just reduce. Possibly including the reuse of water.
- b. Objective 4.2: Implement Resilient Landscape Strategy – Some of this has been accomplished. A revised objective might be ‘implement campus landscape master plan.’
- c. Objective 4.3: Cover Crops on South Farms – There was a discussion around generalizing this to ‘sustainable practices for the South Farms.’ Then, the objective could be divided further into subcategories.

3) IPM for non-F&S areas

- a. Jonathon is working with a team to develop an outline. They are considering the inclusion of a horticulture/ornamental IPM, an IPM for the vegetable and fruit farm, and a greenhouse IPM.

b. The goal is to complete the outline by Dec. 14th.
