## 1) Update on Sustainability in Study Abroad from Eric (Kate)

- a. Kate and Eric met with the Illinois abroad council working group about sustainability awareness in study abroad (Engineering, LAS, ACES) in November.
- **b.** The purpose of the meeting was to get everyone acquainted and to go over reasonable expectations for sustainability in study abroad.
- c. Conclusions were made that there will be future work in integrating sustainability.
  - i. Projects include the CO2 emissions project and Big Impact Small Footprint
    pledge based Big 10 academic alliance.
- **d.** Engineering will become more involved in getting actionable items in place.

## 2) Review of Sustainability Internship Coordinator recommendation

- a. This recommendation was developed from research by a student (Clarissa) to identify models of internship coordinators to connect community projects with students.
- **b.** The School of Social Work Community Scholars' Program provides an avenue for integrating a position to connect local sustainability projects with students.
  - Coupling this position with other responsibilities might help get it off the ground.
  - ii. This position could possibly be the work of a graduate student.
  - iii. Miriam will talk with Emily Stone (School of Social Work) about these possibilities next week.

#### a. Review form
