- Step 4: In these range meetings, to review any of the language we've generated for the definition of what a sustainability course would look like.

- Step 5: Finalize the definitional language for sustainability to be presented to the Gen Ed board
- 3. Sustainability Integration in Study Abroad (Kate)
 - Aiming to involve Grainger, LAS, FAA in study abroad programs that integrate sustainability since there is a lot of interplay
 - Need to be mindful of the logical and practical considerations involved in order to make a positive dent
