The University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign Student Sustainability Committee (SSC) is pleased to inform you that your project has received approval from the Institute for Sustainability, Energy, and Environment (iSEE), and the Vice Chancellor for Student Affairs.

The Student Sustainability Committee is proud to award \$33,655.03 in grant funding for Part 2 Temple Hoyne Buell Hall DDC Upgrade of Room Equipment.

In order to remain eligible for this award, you agree to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. The project must be completed within two years of the funding awarded. A final report of all work completed, a full list of expenditures, and a detailed sustainability impact report must be provided to the SSC Advisor by **December 3**<sup>rd</sup>, **2025**, or project completion.
- 2. Project status updates, and detailed account statements must be provided at the end of each semester until the project is completed.
- 3. The Primary Applicant will be the individual responsible for all official communication and the execution of this agreement.
- 4. The Project Unit Financial Contact must submit the prescribed FPI form for the assignment of a CFOP, within four weeks of receipt of this letter. The CFOP established for this award shall strictly be used for the awarded funds of this proposal.
- 5. Any substantial modifications to the project must be submitted within a scope change form, including modifications to the budget, timeline, project lead, and direction of the project. Scope changes must be approved by a majority vote of the SSC.
- 6. All projects are expected to follow university policies and procedures as well as any applicable local, state, and federal laws.
- 7. SSC reserves the right to revoke funding if the project does not comply with the terms and conditions outlined in this letter.
- 8. Any press releases or educational/promotional materials involving the project must acknowledge SSC funding.
- 9. Any marketing, including but not limited to advertising, signs, and digital ads, involving the project or events surrounding this project must include SSC's logo and/or a statement of which fee funded the project. Projects must coordinate with SSC to ensure promotion appropriately highlights the SSC's contributions to the project.

- 10. The project financial department must submit for alternative funding sources. (Including but not limited to), government subsidies, tax credits, government-funded initiatives, and project grants.
- 11. The Project Financial department will return allocated funds in the secured alternative funding up to the total allocated amount from this SSC project award.
- 12. All SSC-allocated funds recaptured through alternative funding methods must be returned to the University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign's Revolving Loan Fund within 90 days of reimbursement.

#### **Project Description:**

A heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) control upgrade at Temple Hoyne Buell Hall will reduce the building's energy footprint and increase indoor air quality for students, faculty, and staff. Currently, the HVAC controls at the individual room level at Temple Hoyne Buell Hall (THBH) are outdated and failing. This obsolete equipment cannot be programmed to operate efficiently and causes an increase in utility consumption throughout the year, as well as reduced comfort level. This project will replace these controllers with digital Siemens controllers, which will allow custom programming to be implemented that will reduce airflow and better control space conditions.

- 2. Temperature Sensors and Siemens Thermostats
- 3. Valve Actuators and Valves
- 4. Electrical and Occupancy Sensors
