4. The awardee will take the appropriate steps to create a CFOP with OBFS UAFR University Accounting Services. The CFOP provided for this award shall strictly be used for the money awarded in this proposal.
5. Any substantial modifications to project scope, budget, or timeline must first be approved by SSC. These requests must be submitted in a formal letter to the Chair and the Assistant Director.
6. All projects will be expected to follow campus policies and procedures as well as any applicable State and Federal laws.
7. SSC reserves the right to revoke funding if the project does not comply with the terms and conditions outlined in this letter.
8. Any press releases or educational/promotional materials involving the project should acknowledge SSC funding.
9. Any signage involving the project or events surrounding this project should include SSC's logo and/or a statement of which fee funded the project. Projects must coordinate with SSC to ensure promotion appropriately highlights the SSC's contributions to the project.

Project Description:

The goal of the Sustainable World Network is the creation of a well-resourced network of science educators dedicated to the teaching and learning of core sustainability education. To achieve this goal, the team is creating a database of digital sustainability education resources that will be freely available to pre-service and in-service teachers. Additionally, in partnership with local Champaign schools, the team has started to identify already existing networks and approaches to sustainability education. The project will document through teacher and student interviews what is currently happening and of interest to the local community. Two pilot projects with a Champaign elementary and high school will be used as a starting point for this project. With these projects, UIUC students (pre-service elementary and secondary science teachers) will be University representatives working with Champaign in-service teachers and K-12 students to both use and add to the database and to grow the Sustainable World Network.

This proposal directly funds:

- Graduate Hourly (1 graduate hourly for 180 hours per year for 2 years): \$9,262.80
- Undergraduate Hourly (4 students at 5 hours/week for 8 weeks for 2 years): \$4,480.00
- 1 undergraduate hourly (lead undergraduate: 10 hours/week for 8 weeks for 2 years): \$2,240.00
- Graduate Hourly fringe (7.66%): \$872.00



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- Teacher collaborative work stipends (10 teachers per year, 25.00 per hour, 20 hours): \$10,000.00
- Interview stipends (20 interviews per year for 2 years): \$2,000.00
