

Micro Grant Application (Under \$750)

Funding Criteria

A. General Rules

- 1. Undergraduate and graduate students are encouraged to submit requests for funding up to \$750. All projects require stakeholder support in order to have funds awarded.
- 2. Funding can only go to university-affiliated projects on university property submitted from students.
- 3. All SSC projects must make a substantial impact on students. This may be a direct impact or an indirect impact through education and engagement. All SSC funding is 100% from student green fees, so the projects funded by the students must benefit them.
- 4. SSC encourages innovation and new technologies creative projects are encouraged to apply.
- 5. Unless a type of expense is specifically listed below as having restrictions, SSC can generally fund it. The items referenced below should not be taken as comprehensive.
- 6. SSC generally won't fund reimbursement requests.

B. Things SSC Can Fund, On A Case-By-Case Basis

- 1. SSC can fund feasibility studies and design work; however, it must work toward ultimately addressing a sustainability need on campus.
- 2. SSC can fund outreach events with a central theme of sustainability, provided their primary audience is the general campus community.
- 3. SSC can fund repairs and improvements to existing building systems as long as it works toward the goal of improving campus sustainability; however, a preference is shown to projects utilizing new or innovative ideas.

C. Things SSC Will Not Fund:

- 1. SSC will not fund projects with a primary end goal of generating revenue for non-University entities.
- 2. SSC will not fund personal lodging, food, beverage, and other travel expenses.
- 3. SSC will not fund tuition or other forms of personal financial assistance for students beyond standard student employee wages.
- 4. SSC will not fund micro grant proposals that solely request staff, faculty, or student stipends.
- 5. SSC will not fund capital projects using micro grant funding.
- 6. SSC will not fund staff or faculty projects using micro grant funding.

Project Information

1) Provide a brief background of the project, its goals, and the desired outcomes.

This is the 12th annual conference held at UIUC for linguistics research. We are trying to make this conference more sustainable by reducing our waste through encouraging our conference attendees, both from UIUC and from other universities, to bring their reusable water bottles and reuse nametags from previous conferences in addition to not printing programs, buying less materials (notebooks, pens, folders, etc.) and through not using disposable plates, cups and utensils during the snack breaks. The UIUC Union Catering Services charges \$2.50 per person for reusable dishware. We are asking SSC to fund us to pay for this fee for 4 snacks over the course of the two-day conference for 75 people, which amounts to \$750.

The desired outcome for this more sustainable conference is to show conference attendees that conferences can be more sustainable and by encouraging other conference planners and attendees to be similarly sustainable.

2) How will this project improve sustainability at UIUC? In addition to using fewer printed materials provided by UIUC, this will reduce the amount of disposable plates and cutlery going to landfill by reusing the ceramicware already owned by the Union Catering Services.

Moreover, this will set an example for conference goers to think about being sustainable at conferences and while planning conferences.

This project will be located in the Union. No special permission is needed, as the catering service is already located in the building.

We have kept detailed notes of planning and budget since the initial conference that has been passed down to each new executive board. We hope to inspire future executive boards to follow in our footsteps and continue to have sustainable conferences in the future.

As the money will go towards the fees of the Catering Services providing the reusable dishes, Catering Services will return the Union provided space to its original condition.

This conference is planned completely by UIUC graduate students in the departments of Linguistics, Spanish and Portuguese, French and Italian, Psychology, Germanic Languages, and East Asian Languages and Cultures. Moreover, many graduate students and undergraduate students from UIUC present their research at this conference in addition to graduate students from other universities. Moreover, all UIUC students are able to attend the conference for free.
