On behalf of the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign Student Sustainability Committee (SSC), I would like to thank you for considering the funds raised by the Sustainable Campus Environment Fee to implement a project that improves the sustainability of our campus. - 4. The awardee will take the appropriate steps to create a CFOP with OBFS UAFR University Accounting Services. The CFOP provided for this award shall strictly be used for the money awarded in this proposal.
- 5. Any substantial modifications to project scope, budget, or timeline must first be approved by SSC. These requests must be submitted in a formal letter to the Chair and the Assistant Director.
- 6. All projects will be expected to follow campus policies and procedures as well as any applicable State and Federal laws.
- 7. SSC reserves the right to revoke funding if the project does not comply with the terms and conditions outlined in this letter.
- 8. Any press releases or educational/promotional materials involving the project should acknowledge SSC funding.
- 9. Any signage involving the project or events surrounding this project should include SSC's logo and/or a statement of which fee funded the project. Projects must coordinate with SSC to ensure promotion appropriately highlights the SSC's contributions to the project.

Project Description:

Root to Roof is a student-led community design-build center serving the greater Champaign area. Our mission is to empower students through hands-on learning and design thinking by working on real projects that serve community needs. Through previous SSC funding, we are able to use local and sustainably sourced wood to create customized and thoughtful projects for community organizations. We believe the impact is two-pronged:

- 1) Providing students with real projects will give tangible experience and encourage civic engagement
- 2) Leveraging the link to the University in order to build up the surrounding community.
